On your arrival at the hotel please check in at the reception desk, your rooms have already been allocated with your names.

Signing on and event information distribution will take place from 6pm on Friday 16<sup>th</sup> June 2023 in the bar area, or in the garden if the weather is pleasant.

Friday Evening is taken at your leisure, bar meals and drinks of your choice may be purchased if you have not eaten on the way.

The Tour of Exmoor is being run with the aim of recapturing the spirit of the clubs second annual rally run back in 1954, and the 60<sup>th</sup> / 70th Anniversary Welsh tours run in 2012 & 2022.

The original rally was a competitive event covering some 400 road miles and incorporating several special tests, in just 24hrs, no mean feat in those days when the road network was poor and cars not equipped with modern driving aids.

The original route card is enclosed in the road book.

The road book that will enable you to follow the intended/suggested route, this is not compulsory. There has only been one route check carried out in November 2022 so I hope the mileages are correct, there are also no course opening cars so again I

hope you will find that all roads are open, maps are provided should you encounter a problem.

You will find gated roads on this route, if you find them closed please ensure you close them once you have passed through.

**Please note that there will no competitive element to the event.**

### **Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> June**

Breakfast is inclusive in your entry package.

A route of 100 miles has been arranged with the aim of seeing scenic views and interesting places, its all about spending time on Exmoor.

Section one takes you through Dunster over Dunkery Hill with its great view point before descending down into Porlock.

Porlock – Time to explore this small village and visit a coffee shop.

The Second section takes in the private Porlock Toll road before using the coast road to Lynmouth the back up on to Exmoor to Simonsbath.

An opportunity to stop at Boveys Tea room or just zero trip here.

The third section is the longest of the event with many great roads and views.

Withypool Tea rooms are expecting us to stop, parking is roadside only so please park sensibly, I can recommend the cakes!

Section four we return to Northfield Hotel again via Exmoor and Porlock.

A three course dinner has been arranged as part of your entry package and will be served from 7.00pm.

**Your menu choices for the Saturday Evening meal will be taken at breakfast on Saturday Morning.**

Some entertainment has been arranged by Chris & Ben Amor.

### **Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> June**

Breakfast is inclusive in your entry package

A homeward route of 70 miles has been arranged getting you back to the M5.

The first section on Sunday takes you up the coast through Blue Anchor (Plenty of time to stop for a stroll) before heading into and over Exmoor to Dulverton.

Dulverton is a quaint old town and worth a walk around with several coffee shops all within easy walk of the car park.

The second section takes you back up onto Exmoor and heading homeward, a brief Zero Trip point at Raleigh's Cross Inn.

The third section from Raleigh's Cross Inn, we head down off of Exmoor and up and over the Quantocks, the road descending from the top of the Quantocks is narrow but the views are worth it, this section finishes at the National Trusts, Fyne Court.

Again at Fyne Court this is a Zero Trip point although you can stop and explore should you wish.

The fourth section is short and takes you to the finish at Bridgewater Services at Junction 24 of the M5, this is not your usual services and there are plenty of small food outlets to discover here.

On both days there is no need to rush, there is plenty of time to stop and enjoy the scenery and stop locations.

The weekend is very much designed to be relaxed, great scenery, roads and an opportunity to catch up with old friends.

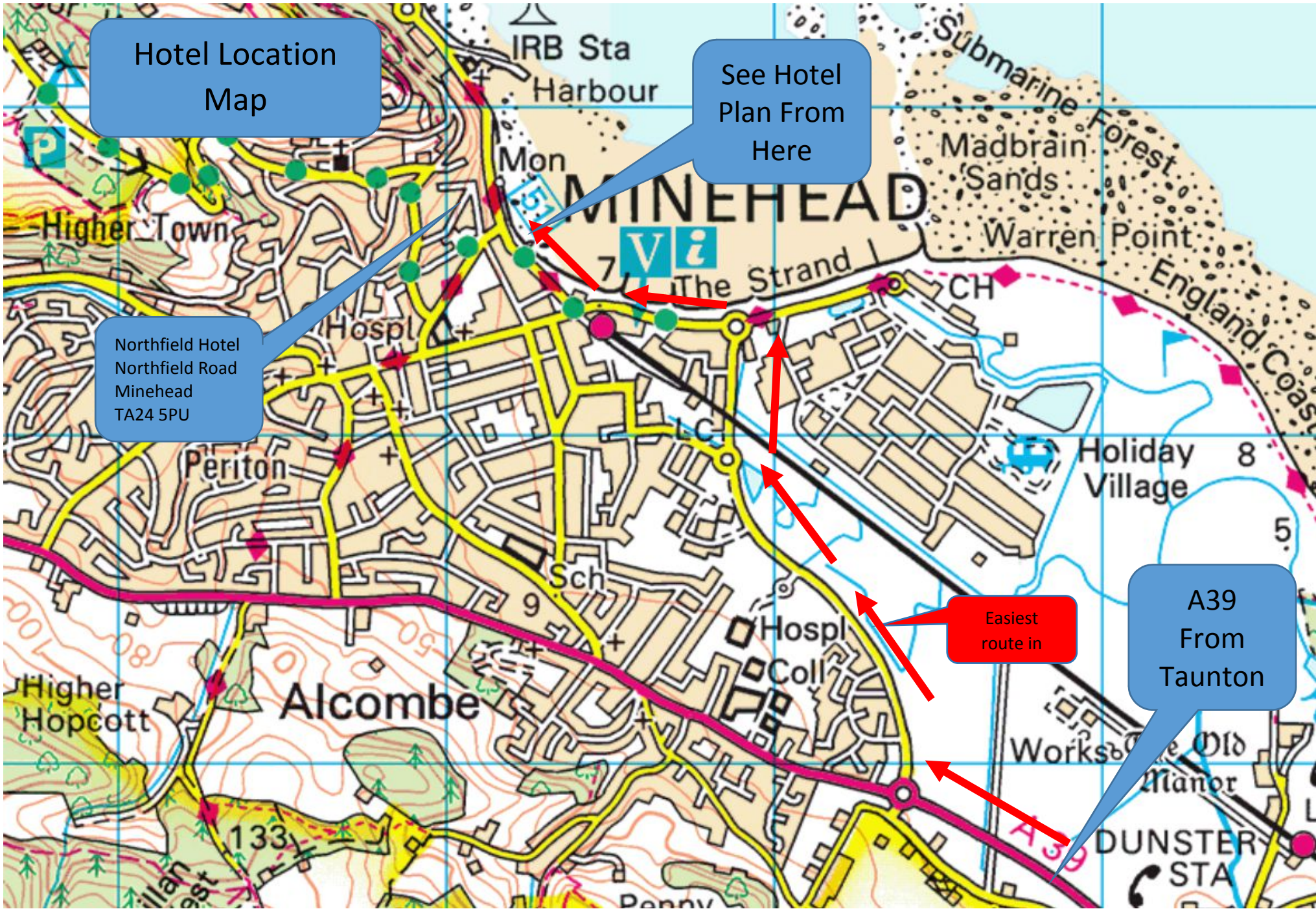
Hotel Location  
Map

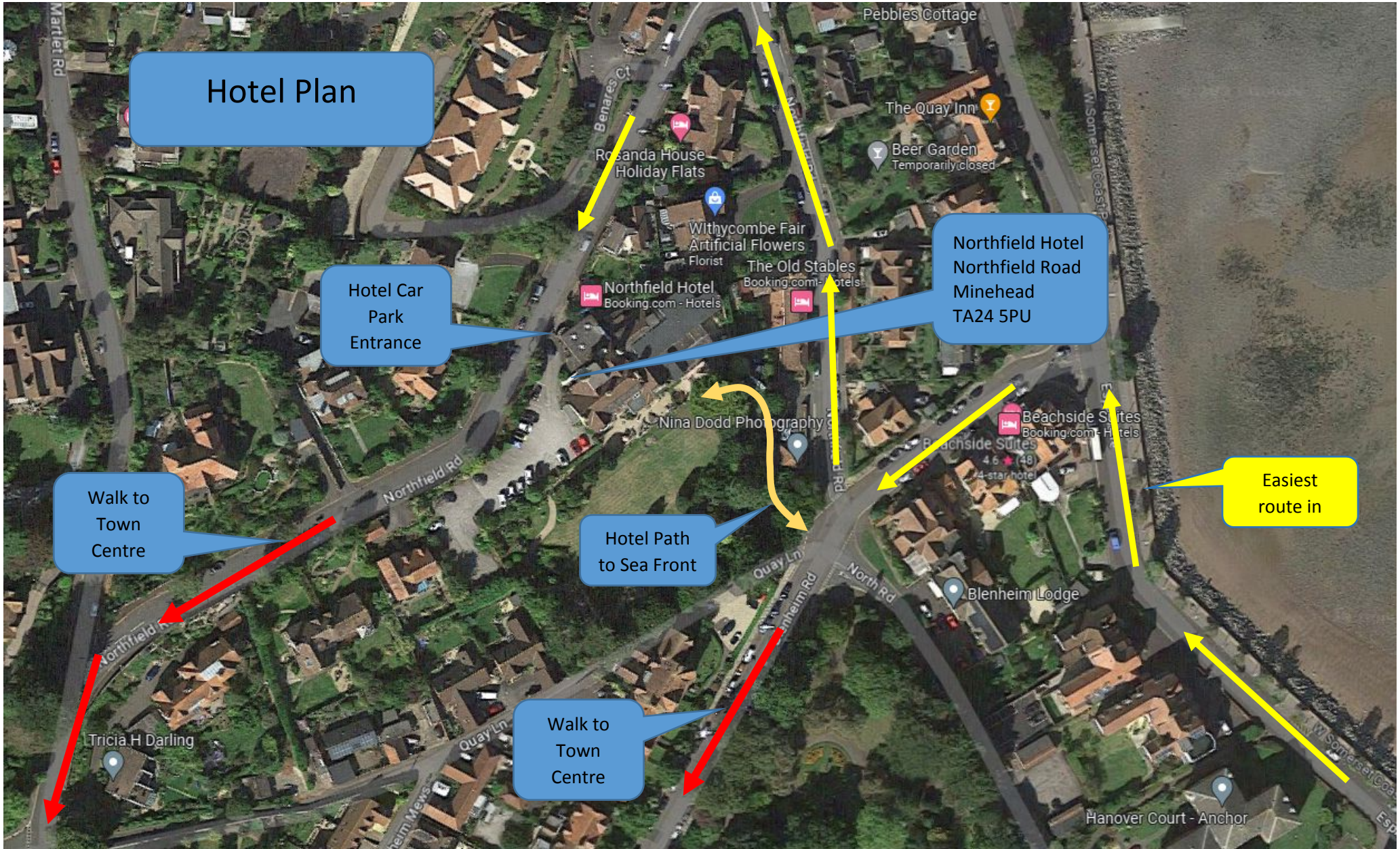
